

# NEW MEXICO HISTORY MUSEUM

The New Mexico History Museum will use the artifacts and stories of the state's past to inspire and enrich the lives of citizens and visitors. For the first time NM will have a museum that honors the state and those who are part of its history and distinctive cultural mix. It will provide a space to present the complex collective heritage through the experiences of those who came before. The New Mexico History Museum exhibits will utilize materials that are intended to capture the special attributes of regional architecture, the quality of light and cultural mix that convey the sense of place that is New Mexico. Fabrication will involve the construction of casework and exhibition spaces complete with textured surfaces and scenic finishes to create immersive environments, production of graphics and large scale photographic murals, and the installation of a variety of historical artifacts. Explus will fabricate and install all exhibit elements as well as all Audio Visual and Media-based hardware and show control systems. Explus will also be responsible for procurement of lighting fixtures and hardware as well as installation of all exhibit lighting hardware.
