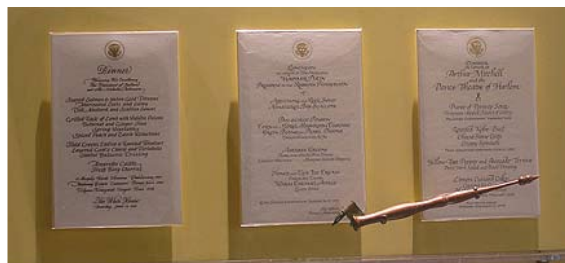


THE WORKING WHITE HOUSE: TWO CENTURIES OF TRADITIONS AND MEMORIES

This traveling exhibit, slated to visit twelve venues after opening in Des Moines, Iowa, at the State Historical Society of Iowa, the exhibition introduces visitors to the White House as a residence, seat of government, and workplace, focusing on all of the individuals who support, and have supported, those functions. Their stories and the occupational culture of the White House are revealed through oral histories, images, and objects.
